The chief advised that he has been using FDonScene version 1.1 software since the license was first purchased in September of 1997. He has for example, used it "several times a year" at both local incidents and mutual aid incidents during Florida wildfires.

The Chief wrote that it "just takes time sometimes" to upgrade to the latest version of a software product. We agree, but hope that most of our customers wait less than eleven years to upgrade to current versions of AIMSonScene incident command and personnel accountability software.

Note that customers who purchase optional AIMSonScene software support (AKA – maintenance) subscriptions receive software updates and enhancements four times per year. The no additional cost updates are contingent upon customers maintaining current support subscriptions.

ETI's product and service line, as well as their history (in business since 1995) nicely compliments AIMSonScene incident

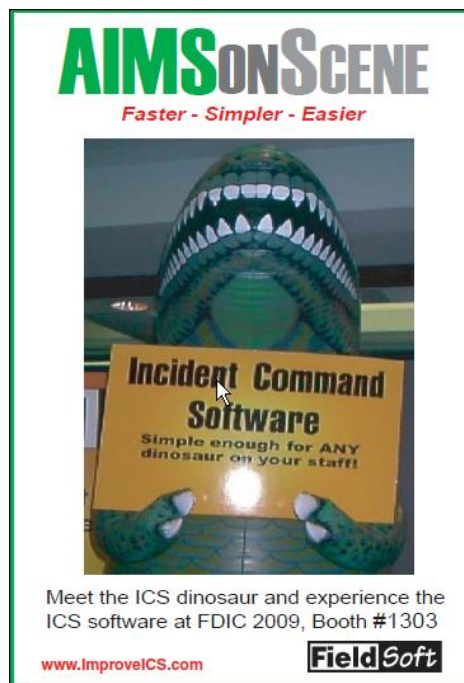
command and personnel accountability software.

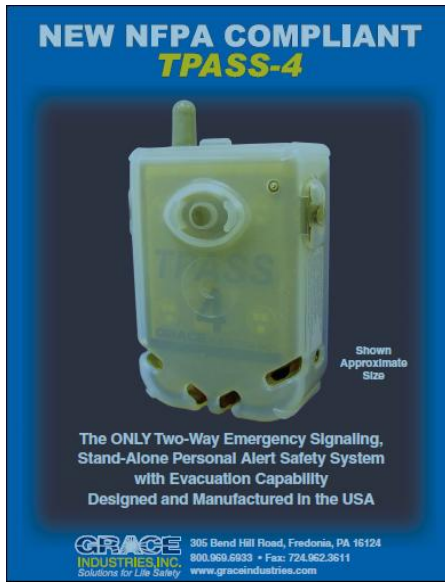
FieldSoft will again be staffing an exhibit booth at FDIC this year. Customers and prospective customers should stop by the exhibit booth.

AIMSonScene updates available for recent versions of the software are cumulative in nature. Cumulative in this instance means you can simply download the latest update and install it without any other intervening steps.

Some customers may wait over a year before updating their currently installed software. Under such circumstances interim updates may, or may not, need to be downloaded and installed.

A frequently asked questions (FAQ) technical support document will be included with AIMSonScene software in the near future. The technical support information will be included as part of the standard AIMSonScene software installation loaded on to computers. Moreover, FieldSoft will also include an updated FAQ with every quarterly software update.
